



## **Pool Rules for the Kenneth R. Dunn Municipal Swim Center**

### **Failure to Comply May Result in Expulsion from Facility**

1. All patrons must either pay an admission fee or show a City-issued pass upon entry to the pool facility. No exceptions.
2. No swimming allowed unless a lifeguard is on duty and the pool area is open.
3. Only children 6 years or younger may use the splash pad unless otherwise approved by Annapolis Recreation & Parks Department staff. Parents/guardians that allow their children to use the splash pad understand that it is at their own risk.
4. All swimmers are **required** to shower before entering a pool or the splash pad.
5. All swimmers must wear apparel that is designed for swimming.
6. All flotation devices must be U.S. Coast Guard certified.
7. Diving is allowed in the lap pool **ONLY**.
8. Any bodily excretions are treated following the Center for Disease Control's guidelines.
9. Swimmers who are not toilet trained must use a swim diaper at all times.
10. Spitting, soiling or in any way contaminating the water, walkways, dressing rooms, or furniture of the pool facility is prohibited.
11. Running, pushing, horseplay and fighting are prohibited within the pool facility.
12. Swimmers are not permitted to hang on lane lines or water features.
13. Balls, dive sticks, water rings, noodles, and similar toys are prohibited in the pool facility except as permitted by an Annapolis Recreation & Parks Department employee during a City sponsored program.
14. Children over 5 years of age AND of the opposite sex from their parent/guardian must either use the family changing room with that parent/guardian or use the other restrooms/locker rooms by themselves or with another adult of the same sex.
15. Children under 13 years of age must be accompanied by an adult at all times within the pool facility.
16. Beverages, food, and gum are prohibited in the pools, splash pad and locker rooms.
17. No glass allowed within the pool facility.
18. Consumption of alcohol, use of tobacco products and smoking are prohibited within the pool facility.
19. Patrons under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs will not be admitted to the pool facility.
20. No photography equipment or cell phone cameras of any kind may be used in the locker rooms, restrooms or family changing room.
21. No amplified music is allowed within the pool facility.
22. No animals are allowed in the pool facility except for service animals.
23. No soap, shampoo or detergents are allowed within the pool or splash pad areas.
24. Strollers, wheelchairs and walkers are allowed within the pool facility, but no other wheeled vehicles, toys or equipment are permitted.
25. The pool facility will close during any severe or dangerous weather conditions, in the sole determination of the Annapolis Recreational & Parks Department.
26. A pool or the splash pad may be closed at any time for routine maintenance or other required repairs.
27. The City of Annapolis and the Annapolis Recreation & Parks Department are not responsible for any stolen, lost or broken personal belongings brought to the pool facility.

**NOT ADHERING TO THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN EXPULSION FROM THE POOL FACILITY WITH NO REFUND OF ANY KIND.**
