I have the following minor comments/questions:

- 1. What is the definition of "smart city traffic signal"? I could not find a definition in the report. Currently, Forest Drives has an adaptive control software (ACS-Lite). Does the report refers to this type of technology? Or does the document refers to a more infrastructure to vehicle communication technology? The report should define what is the meaning of the "smart city traffic signal."
- 2. Please note that the County Executive has signed a Multimodal Transportation Bill (78-18). This bill was created to incorporate multi-modal evaluation during the subdivision review process.
- 3. The County is hiring a consultant to assist with the updating the County's design manual. The update will include new roadway cross-sections that will take into account the complete street approach. The update will also generate new guidelines for Traffic Impact Studies associated with development in the County.
