

PROCLAMATION – MAY 5, 2019



Chartered 1708

MAYOR OF THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

WHEREAS, a vacancy now exist in the membership of the City Council in Ward 6; and

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 7 of the Charter of the City of Annapolis requires that a special election be ordered under such vacancy and requires that the special primary election be held on any weekday other than a state or religious holiday which is at least 23 days but no longer than 30 days from the date of the proclamation; and the special general election be held on any weekday other than a state or religious holiday which is at least 21 days but not longer than 30 days from the date of the special primary election; and

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 7 of the Charter of the City of Annapolis requires the special election to be ordered by proclamation of the Mayor;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GAVIN BUCKLEY, Mayor of Annapolis, under the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Statutes of the State of Maryland, and the Charter and Code of the City of Annapolis, do hereby order a special primary election to be held in Ward 6 on Tuesday, **June 4, 2019**, for the purpose of electing an Alderman or Alderwoman for the City of Annapolis for Ward 6 to serve and fulfill the term which began December 4, 2017.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, GAVIN BUCKLEY, Mayor of Annapolis, under the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Statutes of the State of Maryland, and the Charter and Code of the City of Annapolis, do hereby order a special general election to be held in Ward 6 on Tuesday, **July 2, 2019**, for the purpose of electing an Alderman or Alderwoman for the City of Annapolis for Ward 6 to serve and fulfill the term which began December 4, 2017.

WHEREAS, at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council, or at a special session convened before then by the Mayor or Acting Mayor for the purpose of filling the vacancy, the selected candidate shall be sworn in and seated immediately.

A copy of this order provided immediately to the City of Annapolis Board of Supervisors of Elections; and all appropriate writs will be issued and all proper proceedings will be followed for the purpose that said election may be held to fill the vacancy in Ward 6 and the results proclaimed in accordance with the law.
