

Land Use and Cultural Resources

Transform and enhance character by balancing the small changes such as adding streetscape elements with the larger changes in community character and development patterns. (FDESS)

Series of walkable and bikeable village-like neighborhoods with identifiable connections as gateways and focal points, to other key areas of Annapolis both residential and commercial (FDESS/WASS)

Strengthen existing neighborhoods especially underserved, with improved safety, access, and aesthetics and physical appearance (UWSSS)

Annapolis' rich cultural history and current historic and cultural offerings will be protected and enhanced in part by conserving neighborhoods and harnessing the benefit of preservation requirements (ACP)

Emphasis on maintaining the integrity of Historic Annapolis including layout, scales and vistas, but with gradual improvements worked in serving the changing needs of the City (CDMP)
