18 **FOR** the purpose of establishing a temporary advisory Task Force to provide the City Council
19 with findings and recommendations on the benefits and detriments of the proposed
20 maintenance facility described in the Maintenance Facilities capital project; and generally
21 relating to the Task Force.

23 **WHEREAS,** on June 17, 2019, the City Council approved the establishment of a temporary
24 advisory Task Force to analyze the benefits and detriments of the proposed
25 maintenance facility described in the Maintenance Facilities capital project; and

27 **NOW, THEREFORE,**

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29 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the temporary advisory Task
30 Force commissioned to provide the City Council with findings and recommendations on the
31 benefits and detriments of the proposed maintenance facility described in the Maintenance
32 Facilities capital project be established.

33
34 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the Task
35 Force consider the following issues:

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- 37 • Environmental impacts, including the impact of the existing salt dome and fuel
 - 38 pumps and impacts on City waterways
 - 39 • Land swap, title search, historical significance, easements
 - 40 • Housing – need, type, affordability
 - 41 • Zoning - special exceptions
 - 42 • Traffic and connectivity of communities
 - 43 • Partnerships with Anne Arundel County, the State of Maryland, and the Anne
 - 44 Arundel County Board of Education - including fuel station, pedestrian bridges,
 - 45 and recreational amenities
 - 46 • Quality of life impacts on residents of Wards 1, 4, and 5, including Kingsport,

1 Village Green, Homes at the Glen, Annapolis Walk, the Enclave, and Truxtun
2 Heights - traffic, noise, recreational amenities, and connectivity of communities

- 3 • Impact on businesses
- 4 • Impact on tax revenues and City services
- 5 • Impact on Department of Public Works maintenance employees - working
6 conditions and morale.

8 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that:

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10 1. The Mayor shall appoint members to the Task Force based on their expertise
11 in the subjects being evaluated;
- 12 2. Designees from the Anne Arundel County government, the State of Maryland
13 government, and the Anne Arundel County Board of Education shall be asked
14 to serve on the Task Force;
- 15 3. Task Force members shall serve without compensation
- 16 4. The Task Force shall elect from among their membership a chair, a vice chair,
17 and a secretary;
- 18 5. The Task Force shall have at least one meeting at which the Task Force takes
19 public testimony; and
- 20 6. The Task Force may adopt rules of procedure as it deems necessary and
21 desirable for the conduct of its meetings and activities.

23 **AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE ANNAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL** that the
24 Task Force shall submit its findings and recommendations to the City Council no later than the
25 first regular meeting of the City Council in January 2020.
