Regulations for Outside Burning

1. There shall be no open (on the ground) burning within **FIFTY (50)** feet of any structure.
2. There shall be no burning in an approved container within FIFTEEN (15) feet of any structure.
3. Permission is required from The Fire Marshal's Office for outdoor burning.
4. All outdoor burning, in a container or on the ground, shall:
 - A. Be properly supervised until the fire is extinguished.
 - B. Have a clear area of not less than TEN (10) feet around the burning operation.
 - C. Have adequate tools and extinguishing equipment on hand to control the burning.
5. If in doubt as to the safety of the project, CALL THE FIRE DEPARTMENT.
6. This application and fee (\$25) must be submitted to the City of Annapolis permits counter.
7. Make checks payable to the City of Annapolis.

NOTE: A permit will not be issued by the Fire Department if the proposed method is deemed to be a danger to life or property, and/or if fire, smoke, or gases may be of an obnoxious nature. Furthermore, the Fire Department may prohibit or suspend all outdoor burning operations when conditions make such fires hazardous.
