Bulb ordering begins Monday, September 14

(Annapolis, MD, August 28, 2020) — Mayor Gavin Buckley and the Annapolis Recreation and Parks Department invite community members to participate in the nation's annual [Make A Difference Day](#) by volunteering for the city's fall GreenScape project on Saturday, October 24. [Make a Difference Day](#) is a national effort encouraging groups and individuals to volunteer in their community to improve the lives of others.

Reservations for bulbs starts Monday, September 14. Volunteers may order up to 100 tulip bulbs and 100 daffodil bulbs for each project. This year we will be offering purple tulips and yellow daffodils. *The bulbs are free but only available on a first-come, first-serve basis.*

Due to COVID-19, when volunteers pick up bulb orders, they must be wearing a mask, receive a temperature check and complete a brief questionnaire.
