I, either for myself and/or for my minor child, hereby recognize, understand and acknowledge that the City of Annapolis and its Recreation & Parks Department ("ARPD") are not responsible for any personal injury, damages resulting from personal injury, including death, or property damage/loss suffered while participating in ARPD activities, programs, volunteer events, using any ARPD equipment or facilities, or while on any ARPD property or facility (collectively, the "Recreation Activities"), for any reason whatsoever, including ordinary negligence on the part of the City, ARPD, and its elected officials, appointees, directors, employees, instructors, contractors, representatives, or agents (the "City Parties"). In consideration of my and/or my minor child's ability to participate in the Recreation Activities, I hereby, on behalf of myself and/or my minor child, release and covenant not to sue and release from all liability the City Parties for any and all claims, losses, damages, and suits resulting from participation in the Recreation Activities, both present and future, that may be made by me, or my family, estate, heirs, or assigns on behalf of myself and/or my minor child. I represent that I and/or my minor child is in good health, that I am aware and understand that health and fitness activities may range from vigorous cardiovascular activity to the exertion of strength training and that these and other Recreation Activities involve certain risks, and I and/or my minor child is voluntarily participating in the Recreation Activities with full knowledge of the inherent risks of property damage, personal injury and/or death. I understand that ARPD encourages everyone to consult a physician before beginning any exercise program or undertaking any fitness activities. I hereby understand, acknowledge and agree on behalf of myself and/or my minor child that I and/or my minor child may be photographed or videotaped during Recreation Activities. These photographs and/or videos may be used by the City or APRD, without any notice or permission, in its own publications, in local or online media, or on other social media platforms for advertising, marketing, promotional or other uses. I understand this waiver on behalf of me and/or my minor child to be as broad and inclusive as the laws of the State of Maryland will permit, and affirm that I am of legal age to freely sign this waiver on my behalf and/or on behalf of my minor child. Annapolis Recreation and Parks "Pip" Moyer Recreation Center Membership Policies and Rates

Memberships/Daily Admission: All visitors must either present a membership card or pass the biometrics reading upon arrival. If the visitor is not a member, they must purchase a guest pass to use the facility. **Any child under 18 needs a parent signature on file before they purchase a guest pass.** Program members are only permitted during registered class times. Use of the facility during non-class times requires the purchase of a guest pass that can be purchased at the Front Desk.

Fees: Fees are determined annually by the Annapolis City Council. **Fees stated below are for FY2022 (July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022.)** Fees are subject to change each fiscal year.

Full Membership: Full members are entitled to register for programs or classes and/or use the facility during non-program times including private rentals of meeting rooms (program/rental fees apply) Includes drop-in use of the gymnasium, fitness center, indoor track, Ballocity™ indoor playground (member times only) and rock climbing wall (member climb times only.) Annual paid-in-full memberships are valid for one year from date of purchase. Annual memberships are paid-in-full at time of registration. **NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON ARE GRANTED.** Monthly and 90-Day Access passes are paid-in-full at time of purchase. **NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON ARE GRANTED.** **PUNCH CARDS for 20 visits to PMRC are valid for one year from the date of activation when they are sold or offered.)**

Children 2 and under are free with paying adult, except when using Ballocity™. Family memberships and adult/spouse memberships require all members to reside at the same address. Proof of residency is required. **All memberships are non-refundable and non-transferable and we do not freeze or put memberships on hold.**

Corporate Membership: Corporate members are allowed up to 15 members on the membership. The business is issued 5 cards which can be transferable **within** the company. (Only 5 of the 15 cards (members) are allowed in PMRC at any one given time.)

Scholarships: If residents are unable to participate in programs due to economic hardship, the Annapolis Recreation and Parks Department provides a scholarship program to reduce membership and program fees. Applications, and the complete list of guidelines, are available at the Front Desk. A limited amount of funding is available. Scholarships are for recreation programs and memberships only and do not apply to personal training, supplies, trips or facility rentals.

Residency Status Determination: A *City Resident* is defined as any person living in the corporate limits of the City of Annapolis and paying City taxes. Annapolis mailing addresses or Zip code designations of 21401 or 21403 may or may not qualify someone as a City resident. All members must provide proof of residency including driver's license and utility bill or matching address of a paid tax bill. A *Non-Resident* is defined as any person not paying City of Annapolis taxes. An Annapolis mailing address or Zip code of 21401 or 21403 does not provide proof of residency. Military property is considered outside of the City limits and therefore addresses are considered non-residents. Non-residents are welcome to purchase memberships and guest passes.

Proof of Residency: Acceptable documents showing correct name, current date, and current City of Annapolis address include a valid Photo I.D. (School, Military, Driver's License or Passport) plus one of the following: Unpaid Utility Bill or Personal Property Tax Receipt.

Check-In: The "Pip" Moyer Recreation Center has a card system check-in at the Front Desk to verify current/active memberships.

Additional Info on Memberships, Programs, Rentals and Permits: Members and guests are required to abide by facility rules and regulations.

- Youth aged 12 and younger must be accompanied by an adult while in the facility or be enrolled in the Kidz Zone (on-site childcare, max two hours and extra fees apply.)
- All patrons must be dressed in appropriate attire within the facility including shoes and shirts.
- Alcohol, weapons, chewing gum and/or tobacco products are prohibited in the facility.
- We reserve the right to perform a physical baggage search of any items brought into the facility.
- Solicitation within the building or on the park grounds is prohibited.
- Loitering is prohibited.
- Foul language is prohibited in the facility and may be cause for removal.
- Locks must be removed from locker rooms by closing time; items will be removed nightly.
- Annapolis Recreation and Parks is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items. It is strongly recommended that you lock up items or do not bring valuable items into PMRC.
- Lost or Stolen Permits are not replaced.
- Annapolis Recreation and Parks staff reserve the right to ask for membership verification or membership card at any time, or revoke a membership at any time.
- Cell phone use is restricted to the hallways and lobby only.
